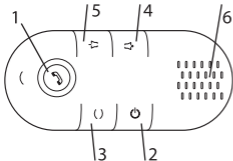




## User's Manual

Thank you for choosing iBOX product. This portable mini-shaped Bluetooth Speakerphone for cars has been specially designed for your safety and convenience. Please always use the Speakerphone for the calls while driving a car. Advanced DSP technology provides you with excellent sound quality.



1. Answer button / LED indicator
2. ON / OFF buttons
3. Messages language switch
4. Volume +
5. Volume -
6. Loudspeaker

## Mobile Phone Matching

Before using the hands-free function, please match your Bluetooth®-enabled mobile phone with the Speakerphone in within 1 metre distance. iBOX CK03 can support 2 phones simultaneously.

1. Press and hold a (2) button for 3 seconds, till you hear the voice saying the device is ON. Don't release the button. Press and hold the button for the next 3 seconds till you hear the voice saying the device is ready for matching, LED indicators will shine alternately with red & blue light. Select Bluetooth function on your phone, then select and choose CK03 device. Enter access code 0000. You will hear the voice saying that the phone is connected. LED indicator is shining with blue light.

2. Connect the second phone: turn off the Bluetooth on the first phone and turn off the Speakerphone. The voice says that the device is off. Select Bluetooth function on the second phone. Repeat all the steps from point 1. Turn on the first phone once again. The Speakerphone will automatically match both devices.

## Speakerphone operation

**„POWER“ button (2)** – Press and hold the (2) button for 3 seconds. The voice says that the device is on. LED indicator will light up. Press and hold the button to turn off the device. The voice says that the device is off.



Button (2) also allows to reject incoming calls. If you press button (2) during the call, your call will be disconnected.

**„HANDSET“ button (1)** – Press to answer the call. If you press the button during the call, then it will be paused (note! The call is not disconnected). Press the button once again to continue the call (if this function is supported by your phone).

Press the button twice promptly to re-dial the last number.

Press and hold the button for 1 second to enable the voice dial feature (if this function is supported by your phone).

**Button (3)** – messages language switch. Press the button to see the list of available languages. Choose the language by pressing „HANDSET“ (1) button during the message.

**Buttons (4) and (5)** – volume +/-

The buttons are used for regulating the call volume.

**„VOL–“ (4) button** – press and hold the button to restore factory settings.

## Charging your Bluetooth Speakerphone

This device have a build-in rechargeable battery with micro USB charging port at the back. The device should be fully charged before the first use. Red light will light up during the battery charging and it will be off when the battery is fully charged. Full charging time takes approximately 3h.

## Warnings
